

SJCPOA Scholarship Application Instructions

The San Joaquin County Probation Officers Association will award five scholarships up to \$5,000.00 annually to eligible recipients. Recipients awarded the scholarship will receive up to \$1,000.00 annually. Applications MUST be received by the Committee on or before June 15th of each year. Applicants must follow all directions; this is part of the eligibility process.

How to Apply

1. Detach and complete the accompanying application. All questions must be answered. Mark N/A if a question does not apply.
2. Applications must be accompanied by an official high school and/or college transcript. In those cases where the school or college will not furnish the transcript directly to the student, a stamped addressed envelope should be supplied.

3. Enclose letters of recommendation that you wish to be considered by the committee.

Who is Eligible?

Scholarships are available to high school and college aged children/grandchildren of active or retired SJPOA members in good standing with the association. Children/grandchildren of deceased SJCPOA members who were in good standing at the time of their death are also eligible.

Applicants must have an overall grade point average (GPA) of 2.5 to be eligible.

Applicants may be awarded only one (1) scholarship per year.

Awarded applicants must intend to further their education during the school year following the award. If a recipient does not enter school during that time, the amount of the award will be returned to the SJCPOA.

Awards & Payments

Five scholarships will be awarded annually up to a maximum of \$5,000.00. Each applicant selected will receive a maximum of \$1,000.00.

All awards are in a general category.

Selected applicants should anticipate receiving the funds no later than July 30th of the given year.

Should an awarded applicant choose not to attend school after they have received the scholarship funds, they are required to return the funds to the SJCPWA.
